

EMPLOYER FAQ's:

Which employers participate in the job fair?

The job fair is for employers interested in hiring students ages 15+ for full-time, part-time and/or seasonal employment. A list of participating employers will be posted in February and will be updated frequently.

How many people attend the job fair?

Typically we have about 1,000 people attend the job fair.

Who will attend the job fair?

We will publicize the job fair to all students in our [eight associate districts](#) (approx. 6500 total) as well as to the adult students in our evening and nursing programs. In addition, anyone who arrives at the job fair will be permitted to attend.

When are employer registrations accepted?

Employers are now being accepted for the job fair. To register, complete the online [registration form](#).

Is there a fee to attend?

Yes, there is a \$20.00 fee to attend. The fee can be paid by check, cash or charge.

What does the registration fee cover?

The \$20 employer registration fee covers a 6-foot table, light dinner for all attendees and event publicity.

How many people can attend per registration?

There is no limit on the number of people who can attend from each business.

What do I need to bring for the table?

Employers can bring anything needed to display their business, provided the materials can fit on a 6-foot table.

How many Employment Applications should I bring?

Most employers bring about 250 applications. Tables are available for students to complete applications and the students are prepared to complete applications during the event.

Will I have access to electricity?

Access to electricity is available on a limited basis and **MUST** be arranged prior to the date of the Job Fair. We will not be able to accommodate a request on that day.

What time do I need to arrive?

Participating employers are asked to arrive no later than 2:30 PM to allow enough time for set-up.

Are any employers not permitted to attend the job fair?

Direct sales employers are not permitted to attend.
